
METHOD OF SALE

ENCLOSURE 4972 – LLECHWEDD

This is the largest enclosure amounting to 1.635 hectares (or 4.04 acres). Llechwedd is sloping to steeply sloping in nature as the name implies. There are views towards the Dyfi Estuary and beyond. The land is approached over a shared farm track on the southern boundary.

ENCLOSURE 3867 - CAE TRIANGLE

Cae Triangle is situated to the west of Cae Llechwedd on the other side of the public footpath. The enclosure amounts to 0.484 hectares (or under 1.2 acres). This field is fairly level in nature.
